The Nailer® is a 100% recycled-content, high-density polyethylene (HDPE) plastic drywall stop or backer. The Nailer installs with flat-head nails or staples and the standard component "Tec" screw for steel studs. Drywall may be screwed or glued to The Nailer or may simply be floated behind the adjacent drywall sheet. The Nailer allows for full-size friction fit insulation in wall cavities and can reduce cracking due to truss uplift.
